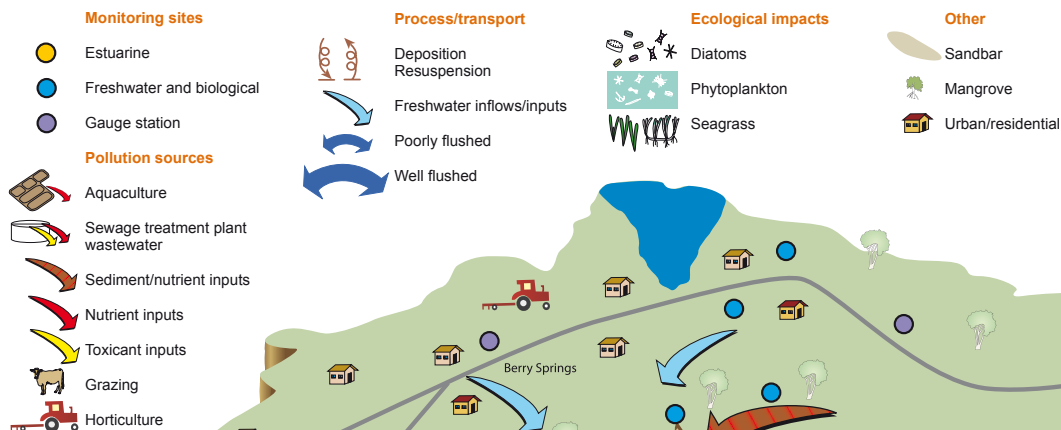


# Monitoring sites, pollution sources and ecology of Blackmore River catchment

## Legend



The diagram shows the Blackmore River catchment, pollutant sources and transport pathways. Sediment and nutrient sources to waterways (shown by arrows) include natural bushland, rural and residential areas. Aquaculture facilities are also a source of nutrients to the harbour. The upper parts of the Blackmore River estuary have deposition and resuspension of sediment, and are poorly flushed by tidal flow. Monitoring sites are shown. Perennial freshwater inflow is from the Darwin River and Berry Creek.
