
Place Names Act NAMING OF PLACE

Note:

Kulumindini Street

meaning 'Emu Dreaming'. This is the traditional dreaming for this area;

Murruliji Street

meaning oasis - sandy ridge and spring - in the swamp to the south

west;

Walanybirri Park

a pelican and also meaning 'gathering altogether'; and

Wilyugu Street

a dreaming place.
