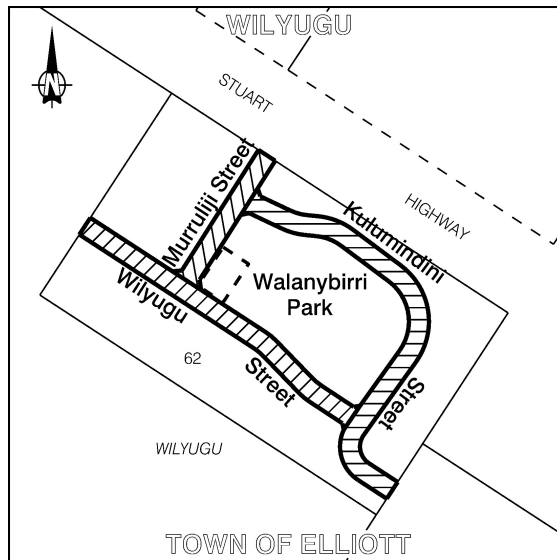
NAMING OF PLACE

I, Gerald Francis McCarthy, Minister for Lands and Planning, under section 11(1)(a) of the *Place Names Act*, approve the recommendation contained in a report of the Place Names Committee for the Northern Territory that the roads shown by hatched lines and the park shown by dotted lines on the map in the Schedule be named Kulumindini Street, Murruliji Street, Walanybirri Park and Wilyugu Street.

| <i>Walanybirri Park</i>   | <i>a pelican and also meaning 'gathering altogether'; and</i>                   |
| <i>Wilyugu Street</i>     | <i>a dreaming place.</i>  |
