ANZAC CENTENARY WALK, BICENTENNIAL PARK, DARWIN

- (a) on the recommendation of the Place Names Committee for the Northern Territory, I have approved the alteration of the name of portions of Atkinson Walk and Federation Walk to Anzac Centenary Walk; and
