

Holtze enabling infrastructure

Part B Package 1 construction works to begin

Dear stakeholder

The Northern Territory Government will begin construction of the Holtze enabling infrastructure Part B Package 1 works.

The works form part of the Northern Territory Government's plan to deliver enabling infrastructure to support residential development in Holtze.

The works involve installing a new trunk sewer main and access chambers, beginning north of the Stuart Highway and connecting to the existing trunk sewer network in Farrar.

Subject to inclement weather, works are planned to commence on 30 March 2026 and include:

- land clearing, excavation and other earthworks
- microtunnelling underneath the Stuart Highway for the trunk sewer main and access chambers
- realigning the existing stormwater and underground power near Farrar Boulevard
- landscaping, including revegetating and grassing

The location of Part B Package 1 works is shown on the map overleaf.

The works will take place from 7am – 5pm Monday – Friday and are expected to be completed by the end of 2026. The microtunnelling works will have extended workdays, Monday – Saturday, and are scheduled to occur between June to August 2026. Stakeholders will be informed prior to tunnelling works commencing.

These works may cause some temporary construction noise and dust in the area consistent with normal construction works. Mitigation controls will be implemented to control the impact of noise and dust.

Stakeholders will continue to be kept informed throughout the construction period of any anticipated impacts.
