


Place Names Act

NAMING OF PLACE

I, DELIA PHOEBE LAWRIE, the Minister for Planning and Lands, in pursuance of section 11 of the *Place Names Act*, approve the recommendation contained in a report by the Place Names Committee that the roads shown hatched on the plan appearing in the schedule be named Hicks Road, Sittella Road and Melaleuca Road, as indicated on that plan.

NOTE:

HICKS ROAD

is named in commemoration of Lieutenant William Hicks of the Brig Mary Elizabeth which provisioned Fort Dundas, and his wife, Sophie, who died on 2/11/1872 becoming the first woman to die at Fort Dundas.

SITTELLA ROAD

is named after the White Winged Sittella (*Neositta leucoptera*), a bird common to the open forest areas of Northern Australia.

MELALEUCA ROAD is named after the *Melaleuca linarifolia*, the "Snow in Summer" - a local native tree.
