

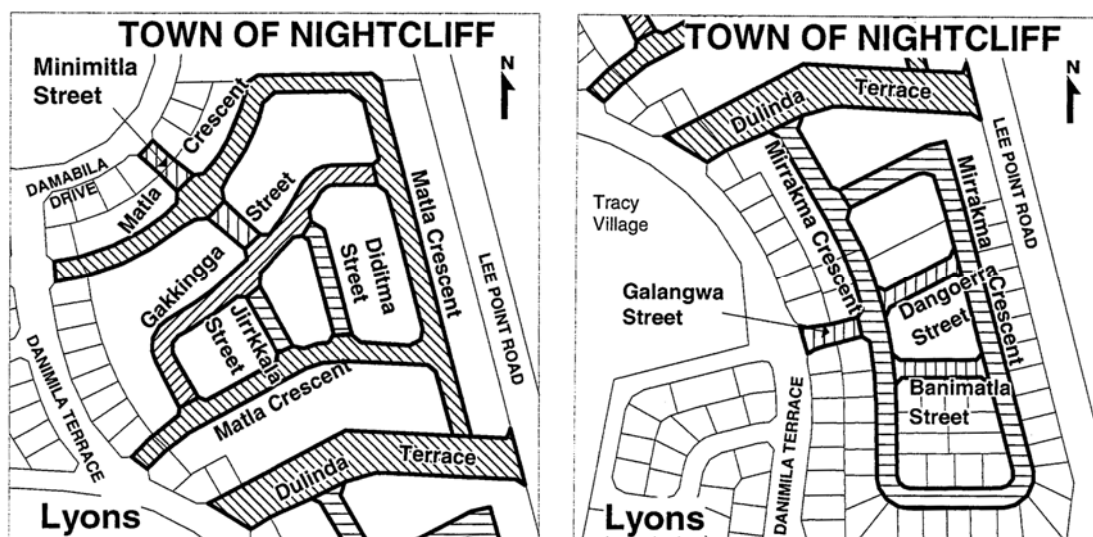
*Place Names Act*

NAMING OF PLACE

I, DELIA PHOEBE LAWRIE, the Minister for Planning and Lands, in pursuance of section 11 of the *Place Names Act*, approve the recommendation contained in a report by the Place Names Committee that the road shown hatched on the plans appearing in the schedule be named Matla Crescent, Minimitla Street, Gakkingga Street, Jirrkala Street, Diditma Street, Dulinda Terrace, Mirrakma Crescent, Galangwa Street, Dangoerra Street and Banimatla Street, as indicated on that plan.

| MATLA CRESCENT    | being the Larrakia name for a crab, pronounced Mudla;  |
| MINIMITLA STREET  | being the Larrakia name for the Echidna ( <i>Tachyglossus aculeatus</i> ), pronounced Minny-midla;               |
| GAKKINGGA STREET  | being a Larrakia name for the Magpie Goose ( <i>Anseranas semipalmate</i> ), pronounced Guckingga;               |
| DIDITMA STREET    | being the Larrakia name for the Peewee ( <i>Grallina cyanoleuca</i> );   |
| JIRRKALA STREET   | pronounced Jeer-car-la, being the Larrakia name for the seagull or Silver Gull ( <i>Larus novaehollandiae</i> ); |
| DULINDA TERRACE   | being the Larrakia name for the the Wild Peanut ( <i>Stericula quadrifida</i> ), pronounced Doo-lean-da;         |
| MIRRAKMA CRESCENT | being the Larrakia name for the cane vine ( <i>Flagellaria indica</i> ), pronounced Mirr-uck-ma;                 |
| GALANGWA STREET   | being the Larrakia name for the Bloodwood tree ( <i>Eucalyptus bleeseri</i> ), pronounced Gull-an-gwa;           |

DANGOERRA STREET

being the Larrakia name for the Emu (*Dromaius novaehollandiae*), and pronounced Dungerra; and

BANIMATLA STREET

being the Larrakia name for the Long Necked Turtle (*Chelodina novaeguineae*), pronounced Banny-mudla.
