

Holtze enabling infrastructure

Upcoming sewer upgrade in Farrar

The Department of Logistics and Infrastructure (DLI) will be commencing construction to install a new sewer main system in Farrar as part of the first package of Holtze Part B enabling infrastructure works.

The works will involve installing a new trunk sewer main and access chambers from north of the Stuart Highway to an existing manhole connection point in Farrar to support the Holtze Development Area. Works are planning to commence in October and include:

- land cleared and excavated to allow construction to proceed
- micro tunnelling underneath the Stuart Highway for sewer main and access chambers
- earthworks to align the sewer main
- realigning the existing stormwater near Farrar Boulevard
- realigning existing electrical lines
- landscaping, including revegetating and grassing disturbed areas.

The location of the Holtze Part B – Package 1 works is shown on the map overleaf.

The Northern Territory Government is planning and delivering enabling infrastructure to support residential development in Holtze in 2 parts; A and B. Construction of part A works started in November 2024 and are expected to be finished in late 2025.

Part B package 1 works in Farrar is expected to be completed by late 2026. Package 2 works will involve the construction of enabling infrastructure including the trunk sewer to complete the sewer main from Linco Road through to Package 1.

Communication with stakeholders, including landowners, businesses and residents will be ongoing throughout construction. Stakeholders in the impacted areas will be provided with 7 days' notice prior to any construction commencing.
