

Holtze enabling infrastructure

Part A construction works now complete

Dear stakeholder

The Northern Territory Government is pleased to announce construction works for Part A of the Holtze enabling infrastructure development are now complete.

The works form part of the Northern Territory Government's plan to deliver enabling infrastructure to support residential development in Holtze.

Commencing in November 2024, Part A works included:

- upgrades and extensions to Glyde Point Road and Linco Road
- upgrades to stormwater drainage and street lighting
- landscaping along roads
- upgrades to underground services to support future development.

The new road alignments along Glyde Point Road and Linco Road are open to the public and enable access to the new residential development, The Parks Living.

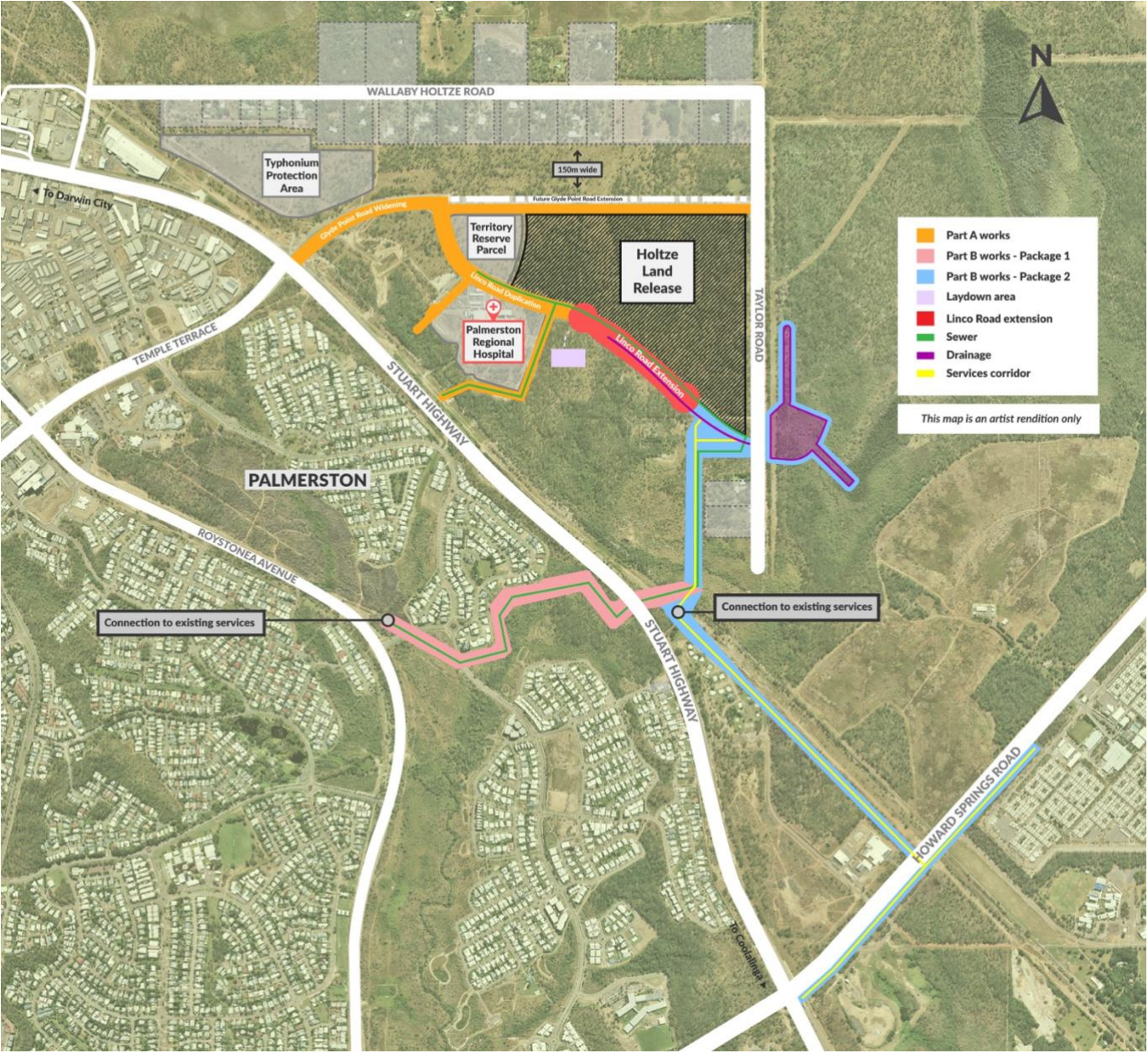
The project delivered strong local benefits, engaging 78 local businesses and supporting 352 local workers, including 29 apprentices.

A key component of the project involved digging deep sewer trenches up to 6 metres in depth. The contractor managed these deep excavation works to deliver them safely with no safety incidents.

Construction of Holtze enabling infrastructure Part B works is underway, with completion anticipated in late 2026. The location of Part A and B works is shown on the map overleaf.
