| Brief Description | <p>To support a number of upcoming projects at Palm Valley, CTP requires additional accommodation units to house contractors engaged to execute those activities. Therefore, CTP is proposing to re-install a temporary accommodation camp which was previously approved under the PV-13 Connection and PV-02 Reinjection System Upgrade EMP. The aforementioned EMP was closed in accordance with regulation 14(b) of the Petroleum (Environment) Regulations 2016 (NT) on 16 September 2020.</p> <p>In relation to the camp there will be no requirement for any clearing as the temporary camp will be placed in an already cleared area in the same vicinity as the existing camp (Attachment 1). The temporary camp will consist of 4 x 4 bedrooms accommodation units (maximum capacity of 16) support on concrete blocks. The temporary camp will be tied into the existing camp facilities including sewerage and potable water, however it will come with its own standalone 40 kVa generator and self- bunded 1000L bunded fuel tank to provide power to the units. Therefore, the maximum capacity of Palm Valley camp at any one time will be 23 persons. The existing dining room and kitchen facilities will be utilised to support any additional contractors staying in the temporary camp.</p> <p>The purpose of this Regulation 22 is include the installation of a temporary camp in the Amadeus Environment Management Plan.</p> |           |                                     |                   |        |         |   |      |            |

All addition sewerage water produced at the camp will be treated by an onsite treatment plant for disposal or removed by a licenced contractor to a licenced facility in accordance with 3.4.3 of the EMP. Any additional waste will be managed according to section 3.4.3 of the Amadeus EMP. Diesel fuel storage and handling will be managed on site in accordance with the Palm Valley Spill Management Plan. | Yes, all of the proposed activities are currently included as part of the approved Amadeus EMP.
