


Place Names Act

NAMING OF PLACE

I, DELIA PHOEBE LAWRIE, the Minister for Planning and Lands, in pursuance of section 11 of the *Place Names Act*, approve the recommendation contained in a report by the Place Names Committee that the roads shown by thick black lines on the plan appearing in the schedule be named Affleck Road, Jarvis Road and Hawks Court, as indicated on that plan.

NOTE:

- AFFLECK ROAD is named in commemoration of Arthur Affleck (b.1903) Commercial Pilot; original pilot for the Flying Doctor Service; worked for Civil Aviation Branch during WWII and in 1942 was responsible for assessing the damage to QANTAS Empire Airways Ltd Hangar at Fannie Bay after the bombing raids;
- JARVIS ROAD is named in commemoration of The Reverend Stanley Jarvis, Pastor, Lecturer and Methodist Missionary; based at the Wesleyan Church in Knuckey Street during the 1920s;
- HAWKS COURT is named in commemoration of Sid Hawks (1907-2004) RAAF Sergeant during WWII, Hotel and Store owner; Proprietor of coastal shipping business; involved in evacuation of refugees from Timor during civil war in 1975.
