Clean-up works progressing for Holtze Development Area

Dear stakeholder,

Site clean-up works as part of the Holtze development are progressing and will soon move further north towards Wallaby Holtze Road.

Clean-up works include the removal of construction debris and other waste such as illegally dumped materials, car bodies, concrete slabs and localised soil stockpiles. Materials will be salvaged for re-use or recycled where possible.

Residents along Wallaby Holtze Road may experience increased work activities between the hours of 7am to 5pm on weekdays, however disruption is expected to be minimal. Mitigation controls will continue to be proactively implemented and monitored throughout the clean-up works and the project hotline remains operational from 8:30am to 5pm, Monday to Friday.

NTEX is undertaking the site clean-up ahead of the Department of Infrastructure, Planning and Logistics' (DIPL) construction of enabling and public infrastructure in the Holtze development area to ready the Crown land for future development.

All site clean-up works are expected to be finished in September 2024.

Please continue to exercise caution while driving and walking in the area during this period.
