1. About the App

Weed ID Deck NT ("the App") is a free mobile reference application published by the **Northern Territory Government, Weed Management Branch** ("we", "us", "our"). It is available on the Apple App Store and Google Play Store.

The App is based on the *Northern Territory Weed ID Deck, 3rd Edition (2021), updated May 2026*, and is designed to assist landholders, land managers, rangers and the general public with identifying declared weed species in the Northern Territory of Australia and understanding recommended management methods.

By downloading, installing, or using the App you agree to be bound by these Terms of Use. If you do not agree, do not use the App.

2. Permitted Use

You may use the App for personal, non-commercial reference and information purposes, or for use within your organisation for non-commercial purposes, provided that:

- Appropriate acknowledgement is made to the Northern Territory Government, Weed Management Branch; and
