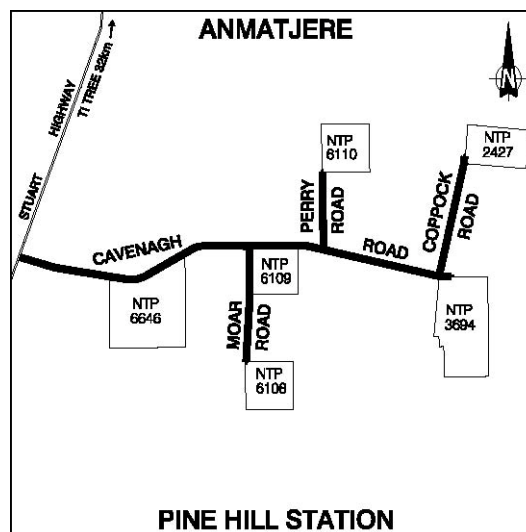
NAMING OF PLACE

| <i>Moar Road</i> | <i>named after Thomas Moar, a pastoralist who held Grazing Licence (GL) 263 (1920/21) and GL 355 (1923/24);</i> |
| <i>Cavenagh Road</i> | <i>named after Frederick Lionel Cavenagh who held Pastoral Lease (PL) 192 (1917-1941), Ambalindum Station, Arltunga;</i> |
| <i>Coppock Road</i> | <i>named after Gilbert and Elizabeth Coppock, pastoralists of Gilbeanie Station from 1930 onwards; and</i> |
| <i>Perry Road</i> | <i>named after C Perry, a pastoralist who held GL 1163 (1945/47) and GL 1037 (1944).</i> |
