

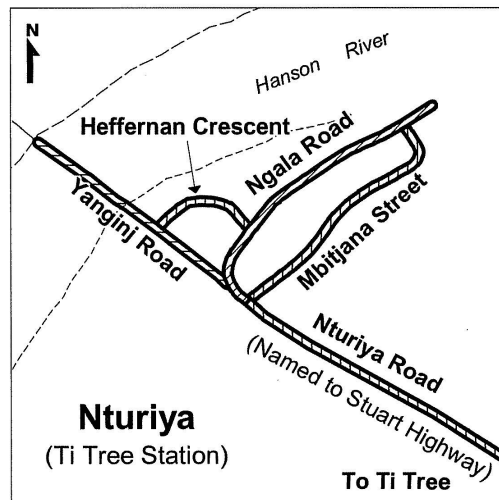
Place Names Act

NAMING OF PLACE

I, DELIA PHOEBE LAWRIE, the Minister for Planning and Lands, in pursuance of section 11 of the *Place Names Act*, approve the recommendation contained in a report by the Place Names Committee that the roads shown hatched on the plan appearing in the schedule be named Nturiya Road, Mbitjana Street, Ngala Road, Yanginj Road and Heffernan Crescent as indicated on that plan.

NOTE:

Nturiya Road

named as the road provides access to the Nturiya community. Nturiya is the local Aboriginal name for a spring in the vicinity of the Community (pronounced En-doo-ria);

Mbitjana Street

a skin name within the community (pronounced M-bit-jarna);

Ngala Road

named in commemoration of the late Mick Ngala (1910-1979) an Aboriginal stockman (pronounced Narla);

Yanginj Road

after the local Lice dreaming (pronounced Yung - inj); and

Heffernan Crescent

after William Joseph Heffernan (1884-1969), pastoralist and serviceman, who held the original Ti-Tree Station lease.
