
Place Names Act NAMING OF PLACE

Kurkunytjingi Road being the Pitjantjatjara word for sweet honey

on Mulga tree;

Kalleske Street after the late Pastor Leo Kalleske;

Kulypiriya Street being the Dreaming of Lady lives in caves at

Utju;

Koschade Court after Ida Huberta Koschade (1874 – 1972),

Areyonga's first school teacher;

Tawara Court being the Pitjantjatjara word for Men's Place;

and

Tjurpintja Place being the Pitjantjatjara word for swimming.
