Did you know that you can REDEEM some cash on certain containers when you RETURN them?

You're already paying an extra 10 cents when you purchase drinks in eligible containers. These include glass bottles, cans, plastic soft drink and water bottles (up to 3 litres) plus fruit juice and flavoured milk cartons (less than one litre).

You get this 10 cents back when you return the containers. Look for the 10 cents refund mark on containers to make a difference and claim your refund today.

Every container returned is then remade into a new one or something else new. This keeps it out of the environment and inside our economy.

So it's good for the environment and your back pocket.

It's a no brainer really.
