
Place Names Act

NAMING OF PLACE

NOTE:

McMINN STREET

Named after Gilbert Rotherdale McMinn, a Senior Surveyor in the Goyder expedition to establish Palmerston (now Darwin) in 1869 and appointed Government Resident of the Northern Territory.

STOKES HILL ROAD

Named after the adjoining Stokes Hill believed to be named in April 1865 by WP Auld, a member of BT Finniss' expedition to Escape Cliffs, who carried out an expedition from Escape Cliffs to Port Darwin.
